I have been an AAAS member since 1976 and I have watched AAAS and *Science* become increasingly engaged in advocacy on several contentious scientific issues, particularly issues that involve government regulations. I described three examples of this advocacy in my July 7, 2024 talk "AAAS and *Science* Magazine Promote Anti-Science"

My evidence of advocacy was reinforced in the July 26, 2024 *Science* Special Issue on Air Pollution

(<https://www.science.org/toc/science/385/6707>). This issue contains highly controversial and unproven claims like "Air pollution causes premature death and disease and disproportionately harms non-white and lower-income groups in the United States"

AAAS and *Science* should provide forums where "both popular and dissenting viewpoints are thoughtfully subject to reason and evidenced debate"
