Dear Commissioner Katz,

I request the opportunity to discuss with you two important issues involving LADWP. I am a physicist-epidemiologist who has had a long academic career at UCLA and I am a LADWP ratepayer. First, I challenge the accuracy and objectivity of climate science used by the Science Based Targets Initiative (SBTi), which is described in a February 3, 2023 LADWP news item (<https://www.ladwpnews.com/ladwp-the-first-municipal-utility-in-north-america-to-establish-science-based-targets-to-further-its-commitment-toward-a-clean-energy-future/>). I have strong evidence that there is NO climate crisis in California (<https://co2coalition.org/publications/an-open-letter-to-the-california-air-resources-board/>). Second, I support the concerns about LA100 described in the July 1, 2024 LADWP Ratepayer Advocate OPA Report (https://ens.lacity.org/opa/importantdoc/opaimportantdoc3249181736_07122024.pdf).
