I am writing again because you have not addressed the scientific and economic criticism of LADWP LA100 described in my October 7 email below. I cannot present this criticism in person today to the Energy and Environment Committee regarding Item No. 21-0352

My top three concerns are: 1) the high current LADWP electricity rate (\$0.29 per kWh) is projected to increase four-fold because of LA100; 2) LA100 is NOT scientifically justified because there is NO "Climate Crisis" in California; and 3) LADWP ratepayers as a whole have not been informed of LA100 itself and of the criticism by the LADWP Ratepayer Advocate and scientists like myself. It is very important that the Energy and Environment Committee and the LADWP Board of Commissioners understand this criticism as soon as possible.
